## About us:

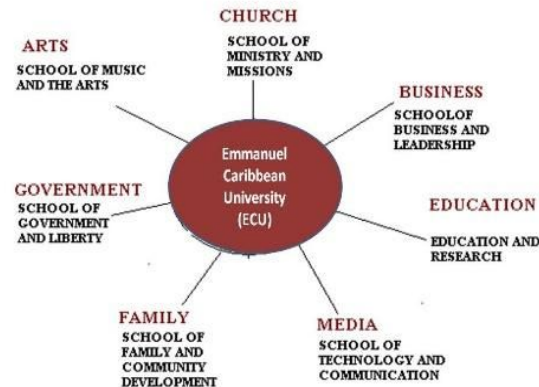
